

While the colors present on a single piece of tile will be indicative of the colors to be expected on the other tiles, the amount of colors on each piece may vary significantly. For example "that little bit of color" on one piece of tile may be the primary color on the next piece.

WEAR CODE

Lappato: Class 4 All Residential and Light Commercial Applications. Class 4 tiles may be used in all residential areas and light commercial applications. (i.e., restaurants, offices)

Matte: Class 5 Suitable for all Residential and Commercial Application. Class 5 tiles are suitable for all applications including those with heavy traffic and constant use. (i.e., Shopping Malls, Hospitals)

It is not recommended to stagger any tile longer than 18" more than 1/3 the length of the tile. Always inspect materials prior to installation.

Always mix 2-3 cartons at a time while installing to insure the best blend.

We recommend a minimum grout joint of no less than 3/16" for pressed tiles.
